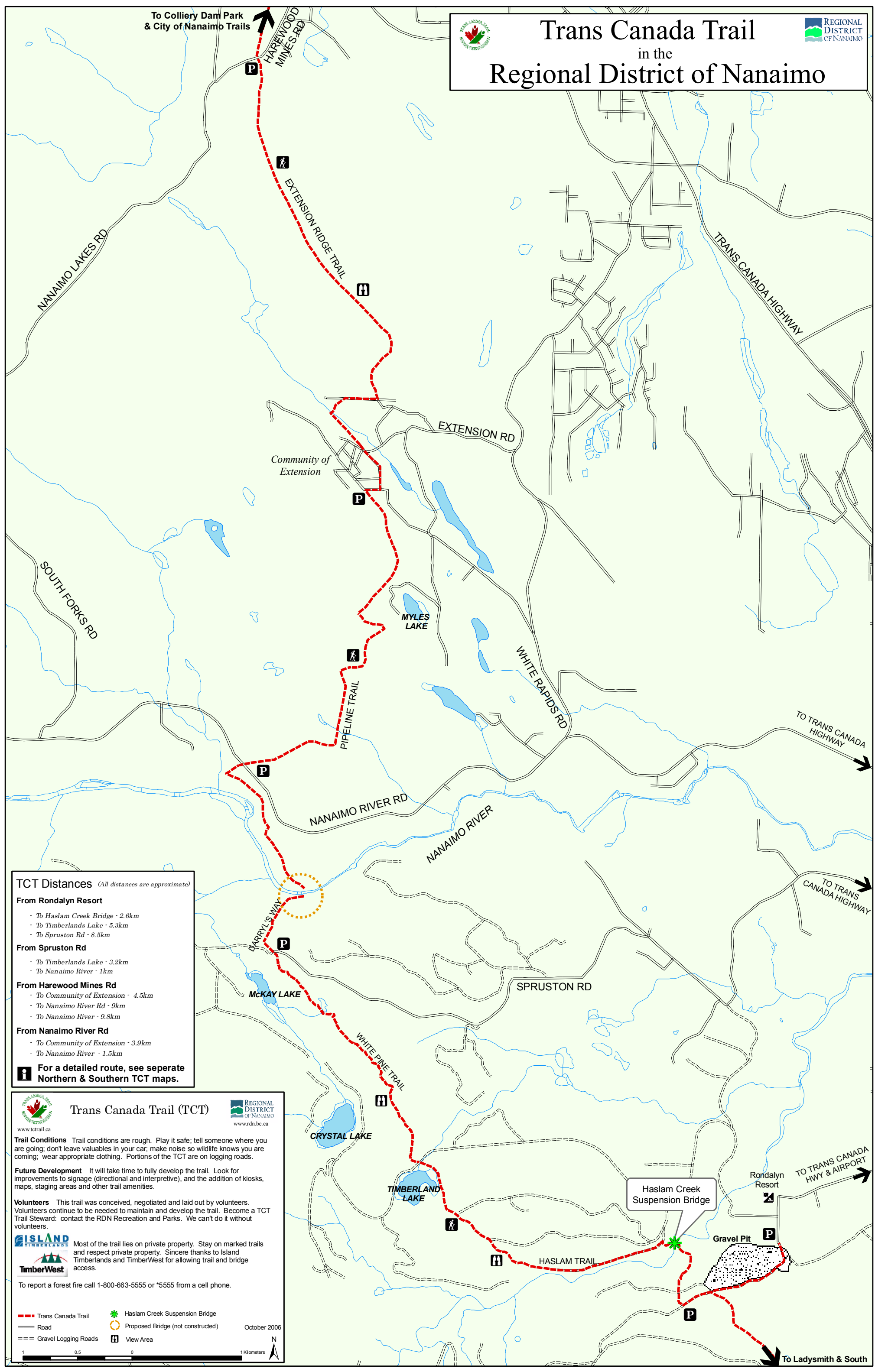




Trans Canada Trail

TCT Distances (All distances are approximate)

From Rondalyn Resort

- To Haslam Creek Bridge - 2.6km
- To Timberlands Lake - 5.3km
- To Spruston Rd - 8.5km

From Spruston Rd

- To Timberlands Lake - 3.2km
- To Nanaimo River - 1km

From Harewood Mines Rd

- To Community of Extension - 4.5km
- To Nanaimo River Rd - 9km
- To Nanaimo River - 9.8km

From Nanaimo River Rd

- To Community of Extension - 3.9km
- To Nanaimo River - 1.5km

Trail Conditions Trail conditions are rough. Play it safe; tell someone where you are going; don't leave valuables in your car; make noise so wildlife knows you are coming; wear appropriate clothing. Portions of the TCT are on logging roads.

Future Development It will take time to fully develop the trail. Look for improvements to signage (directional and interpretive), and the addition of kiosks, maps, staging areas and other trail amenities.

Volunteers This trail was conceived, negotiated and laid out by volunteers. Volunteers continue to be needed to maintain and develop the trail. Become a TCT Trail Steward: contact the RDN Recreation and Parks. We can't do it without volunteers.
