



Step 1: Pre-Approval Application

WaterSmart Landscapes Rebate

Irrigation Improvements & Soil & Mulch Amendment

This rebate applies to residential Regional District of Nanaimo Water Services customers. Applicants can apply for rebate funding to assist with the improvement of landscape water efficiency. This incentive offers rebates in two efficiency areas:

- ◆ **Irrigation Retrofit Rebate (up to \$550 available):** for improving the efficiency of existing residential irrigation systems through the installation and proper use of efficient irrigation system components. See the Irrigation Efficiency Improvements Document Submission Form for the full list of the eligible improvements under this program.
- ◆ **Soil & Mulch Amendment Rebate (up to \$100 available):** for the amendment of existing on-site soils through the addition of high quality compost, topsoil and bark or other organic mulch to improve soil health & water retention.
- ◆ An **efficiency bonus of up to \$100** in additional rebate funds is available to applicants who are pre-approved for both an Irrigation Retrofit Rebate and a Soil & Mulch Amendment Rebate.

Funds are limited and available on a first come first serve basis. If you qualify for the rebate, a pre-approval letter will be (e)mailed to you. Approved applicants must submit their Document Submission package within four months of the date on the pre-approval letter, complete with purchase receipts and post-installation photos. Please review the program requirements and Documents Submission forms on the rebate website (www.rdnrebates.ca) prior to beginning your project, to ensure you are informed of the requirements for program eligibility.

Approximately 6mm (1/4 inch) for lawn areas, and 75mm (3") for garden beds is the required depth of soil amendment to be eligible for the rebate program. 50mm (2 in) is the required depth of mulch in garden beds for eligibility to the rebate program. In addition, applicants must be top dressing at least 400 sq ft of landscape area.

the yard/garden areas to receive soil amendment, top dressing, or mulch application.
