Snaw-Naw-As (Nanoose First Nation) Custom Transit Agreement

The Board approved the Community Transit Partnership Agreement between the RDN and the Nanoose First Nation.

Recommendations for the 2013 Use of Community Works Program Funds

The Board directed staff to amend an agreement with the Island Futures Society to transfer Community Works funding allocated to Electoral Area B for their purchase of a bus, bus shelters and signage to be used in the Gabriola Island Community Bus System.

Compressed Natural Gas Transit Facility Upgrade

The Board directed staff to enter into a contract with Clean Energy Fuels to upgrade the RDN Transit Shop maintenance facilities to make them CNG compliant.

Ravensong Aquatic Centre 2013 Update on Expansion Costs Report
