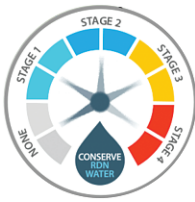

## CURBSIDE ORGANICS CART TIPS

Where do my curbside organics go? Curbside organics materials, now including leaves, grass and light yard trimmings, are taken to Convertus Nanaimo composting facility located in Duke Point. There the materials are screened for contaminants, processed with in-vessel industrial composting technology, and then sold to local end markets.
