The RDN is pleased to resume the Performance Recognition Ceremony, on hold since 2020, to honour these achievements. Nominations for residents who live in the Oceanside area and meet the recognition criteria are being accepted until Friday, October 20, 2023.

Nominees must be residents of the City of Parksville, Town of Qualicum Beach or Electoral Areas E, F, G, or H and have achieved their gold medal or first-place standing between 2020 and the nomination deadline. Past nominees have been recognized for their achievements in swimming, lawn bowling, volleyball, lacrosse, weightlifting, cycling, poetry and many other provincial and national sports and cultural competitions.


The ceremonies will again be held twice annually in the spring and fall. Nominations received by the October 20 deadline will be considered for the November ceremony. Nominations submitted after this date will be considered for future ceremonies.
