

Aquifer Storage and Recovery – Trial Phase Construction

The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. The Regional District of Nanaimo reserves the right to waive minor informalities in or reject any or all tenders, or accept the tender deemed most favourable in the interests of the District, as detailed in this invitation and the tender documents. Tenders not conforming to the specified requirements may be returned to the Tenderer without consideration.
