

Updated Detour Notice

Ammonite Falls Regional Trail

Timber contractors continue to clear wind throw southeast of Benson Creek Falls Regional Park in Vancouver Island University's woodlot. The harvest area contains the Ammonite Falls Regional Trail, which provides access to the south end of the Regional Park and Ammonite Falls itself. For safety, trail users are being routed around the industrial work area on a signed detour within the woodlot which will remain in effect until the wind throw clearing has been completed.

The detour route starts where the Ammonite Falls Regional Trail leaves Jameson Main. This trailhead has been closed temporarily, and users are directed further west along Jameson Main about 700 m to a woodlot trail called Ammonite Way. Users can then head north on Ammonite Way and, about 400 m along, rejoin the Regional Trail and take the usual route to the Regional Park and falls. Trail conditions along the detour route are rough but passable.

Detour Period in Effect until Further Notice

(weekends excepted)

To avoid the detour, trail users are reminded that access to Ammonite Falls is always available via the Weigles Road entrance to Benson Creek Falls Regional Park, home of Ammonite Falls.

Play it safe and respect all posted trail closed and detour signs.
