BE PREPARED RDN - FLOODING



The RDN has lands prone to seasonal flooding, particularly low lying Coastal areas and near rivers and streams. Residents are recommended to prepare early if residing in an area prone to flooding, and to keep sandbags in place until spring if in use. For tips on how to prepare your home and property:

- Be knowledgeable of building setbacks from watercourses
- Know how to shut down your main power system(s)
- Be aware of how to unplug all appliances, big or small
- Have bags packed in case you need to leave on short notice, and prepare a Household Emergency Plan with your family
- If you are in a flood prone area, monitor Environment Canada weather warning for heavy rain and snow melt events
- Listen to local officials if you are asked to evacuate

This may take several days depending on the severity of the weather.

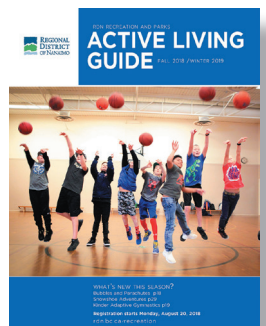
New Year's Eve Free Family Celebration
