- 1. Question:** Is the Regional District of Nanaimo expecting ongoing engagement with stakeholders throughout the project or is a single information session sufficient with continued collaboration as needed?

**Answer:** The successful proponent will be developing a CWRP for each of the seven Electoral Areas. It is important that each individual CWRP reflect a range of local knowledge and expertise. The proponent should outline how it proposes to engage and collaborate with key stakeholders to reflect a community-driven and collaborative plan.

- 2. Question:** Scope of Services specifically d) Hosting an information session (s) for members of the public to explain the process of developing the CWRP as well as answering any questions that members of the public may have. Can you clarify what the expectation is for engagement?

**Answer:** The successful proponent will be developing a CWRP for each of the seven Electoral Areas. This will require an information session for members of the public in or for each of the individual seven Electoral Areas. Virtual meetings will be accepted, and overlap may be considered with neighbouring Electoral Areas. The RDN will support the proponent with a project website where information, surveys or other suggested activities can be published.
