## Campfires Banned at Horne Lake Regional Park and Descanso Bay Regional Park Campgrounds

As of 12 p.m. on Wednesday, June 30, campfires are banned at both Horne Lake Regional Park and Descanso Bay Regional Park campgrounds. Use of CSA or ULC approved propane cooking stoves, barbeques and portable fire pits are still allowed at the campgrounds.

The public is reminded that outside of the two designated RDN campgrounds, fires of any kind, as well as smoking and vaping, are always prohibited in RDN regional and community parks and trails.

This action is in keeping with the campfire ban directive recently released by the Province of British Columbia for the Coastal Fire Centre and is due to increased daily temperatures with no precipitation in the immediate forecast. Please play safe and help protect our forests.
