

Regional District of Nanaimo Invites Public Input on the 2022-2026 Budget

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) invites RDN residents to share their thoughts on what priorities they would like the Board to consider in the 2022-2026 budget. Input collected from the survey is provided to the Board as part of the budget review process and helps identify what areas of service are most important to RDN residents. Helpful background information such as what is budgeted for each electoral area, where the funding comes from and what RDN services are provided is available on the RDN Budget Talks webpage.

“From parks, recreation and water to garbage collection and transit, there are many areas of service provided by the RDN that impact the daily lives of residents and have significant budget implications,” said Tyler Brown, RDN Chair. “Public input is an important part of the budgeting process and we hope RDN residents will take advantage of this opportunity to share their thoughts and budget priorities with us.”

RDN residents can Get involved, ask questions and share input by:

- Registering at getinvolved.rdn.ca/rdn-budget-talks. This two-way communication tool enables residents to complete the budget survey and get their questions answered by the RDN Finance Department. All questions and answers will be displayed on the webpage so others can see what is being discussed and gain insight into the budget process.
- Reviewing budget and property tax information for their electoral area.
- Watching videos that provide an overview of the RDN and the budgeting process.

The preliminary 2022-2026 budget will be presented to the Board at the November 9, 2021 meeting with further discussion occurring at the November 23 meeting. The final 2022-2026 budget will be presented to the Board in February 2022.
