#### **Questions and Answers**

*This following is a compilation of questions received from possible proponents up to 3:00 pm on Friday, September 10, 2021*

##### **(1) Question**

What is the future for the RDN adding more electricians to its staff?

##### **Response**

Staffing requests are subject to approval by the RDN Board. There may be the possibility additional personnel with electrical trade qualifications could be retained during the term of the contract.

##### **(2) Question**

How will work be awarded to Proponents selected in this process?

##### **Response**

Work would be assigned based on the process discussed in **Schedule A** in **Section 1.0 Scope of Work**.

Work less than \$5,000 would be assigned on an “as needed” or “when requested” basis based on the sole discretion of the Senior Instrumentation Technician or designate. Work between \$5,000 and \$20,000 will require a quotation and the quotation will be reviewed by the Senior Instrumentation Technician or designate, and only if accepted by the Senior Instrumentation Technician or designate will the Contractor proceed. The selection of which Contractor would be sent the request would be at the sole discretion of the Senior Instrumentation Technician or designate.

A quotation would be required from all firms selected in this RFP for work between \$20,000 and \$50,000.
