

The RDN Board will consider all submissions and comments and possible impacts of a Non-Medical Cannabis (NMC) retail store on the community. With this, the Board will provide a recommendation to the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch (LCRB) to approve or deny the proposed NMC retail store licence for the property shown in the Location Map below.
