**Regional District of Nanaimo COVID-19 Update**

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) has the following updates and reminders for the public in response to the latest provincial health [orders](#).

**Masks**

- As of 12:01 a.m. on Friday, March 11, 2022, masks are no longer mandatory in RDN facilities or on RDN Transit vehicles.
- The RDN respects the choice of individuals who wish to continue to wear a mask in our facilities and programs.

**Proof of Vaccination (PoV)**

- Proof of vaccination (PoV) is still required (by Public Health Order) for all participants and spectators at both Ravensong Aquatic Centre and Oceanside Place Arena except those under 22 years of age participating in indoor recreation and sport programs that are for children and youth.
- Valid photo government picture identification for ages 19 and over is required alongside the PoV.
- PoV requirements are scheduled to be lifted at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, April 8, 2022, by the province.
