

Dashwood Fire Hall Replacement Project - Alternative Approval Process

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is proposing to amend the Dashwood Fire Hall service bylaw to facilitate additional borrowing of up to \$2,243,662 to finance the costs of constructing a fire hall to serve the Dashwood Fire Hall Service Area. The borrowed funds would be repaid over a period not to exceed 25 years. As funding for this property acquisition requires borrowing, affected electors must approve the following bylaws through the Alternative Approval Process (AAP) before this purchase can proceed:


- Dashwood Fire Hall Service Amendment Bylaw No. 1785.01, 2022
- Dashwood Fire Hall Loan Authorization Amendment Bylaw No. 1789.01, 2022

The Alternative Approval Process for these bylaws runs from May 18, 2022, to 4 p.m. on June 27, 2022. Electors in the participating service area of Electoral Area's F, G or H outlined in the accompanying map who oppose the proposed bylaws can submit an Elector Response Form during this time period and electors who support the bylaws do not need to take action.

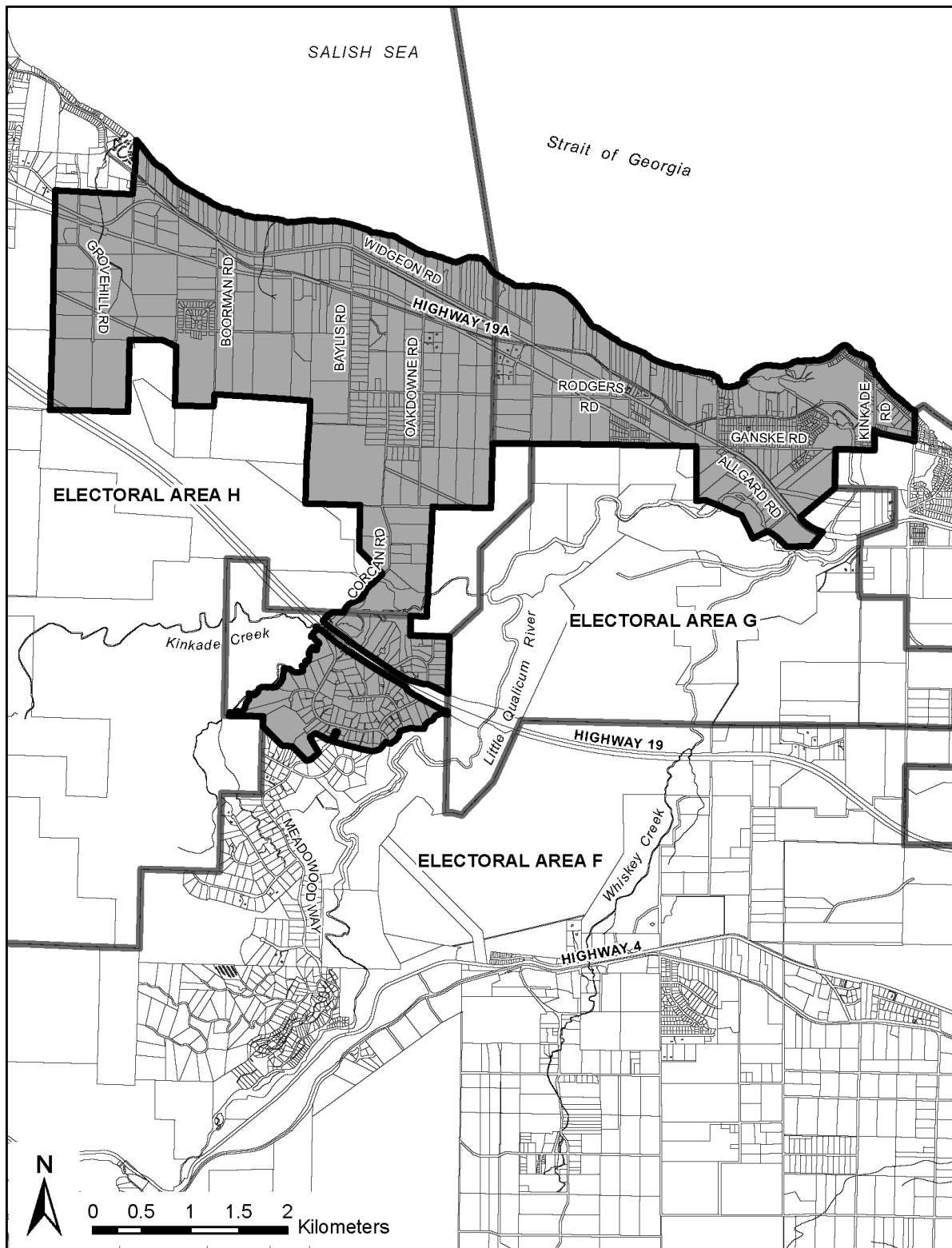
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
