- 3.1 The Tenderer declares that it has read and understood and agrees to be bound by the Tender Documents.
- 3.2 The Tenderer declares that it has fulfilled and complied with all the obligations and requirements under the Tender Documents which are required to be fulfilled by the Tender Closing.

- 3.3 The Tenderer confirms, represents, and warrants that all information which it has provided or will provide to the Regional District is true and accurate in every respect.
- 3.4 If the Tender is accepted by the Regional District, the Contractor shall commence the Work within 5 working days after issuance of the Notice to Proceed from the REGIONAL DISTRICT unless otherwise stated. The Contractor agrees to attain Ready-for-Takeover by June 28th, 2024.
- 3.5 All prices are to be shown in Canadian currency.
- 3.6 The Tenderer hereby submits a lump sum price as required by the specifications and agrees that this price will be used for payment of work through approved Progress Payments. Any Extra Work will require a change order. The Tenderer agrees that the prices quoted shall remain in force until the date of completion of the Contract.
- 3.7 The Tenderer confirms that the Tender Price includes all necessary costs including but not limited to supply, fabrication and finishing, conveyance and delivery to Site, packing, crating, freight, cartage, shipping charges, off-loading, installation, construction, drafting charges, labour, overhead, profit, etc. and all tariffs, duties and taxes unless otherwise indicated, including British Columbia Provincial Sales Tax. The applicable Federal Goods and Services Tax shall be shown as a separate item to the Tender Price.
- 3.8 The Tenderer agrees to be deemed to be the Prime Contractor within the meaning of Part 3, Division 3, Section 118 (1) of the Workers Compensation Act and is qualified and willing to assume this responsibility.
- 3.9 All payments will be subject to a 10% holdback as per the BC Builders Lien Act.
- 4.0 The Tenderer shall, within 7 Days of receipt of notice from the REGIONAL DISTRICT, submit a full and complete breakdown of the Tender Price showing the value assigned to each part of the Work including an allowance for profit and overhead. In submitting the breakdown, the Tenderer shall certify that the value assigned to each part of the Work represents the estimate of the actual cost, including profit and overhead, of performing that part of the Work. It is understood that these itemized prices are provided for information purposes only and exclude GST.
- 4.0 Tenders must be accompanied by a **verifiable digital Bid Bond (E-Bond)** in an amount of 10% of the Total Bid Price and a **verifiable digital Consent of Surety** as defined by the Surety Association of Canada.
