RDN Seeking Volunteers for Advisory Committees

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is seeking volunteers to sit on several RDN advisory committees with terms ranging from one to three years. Members of the public who have experience or interest in the areas of parks, recreation, culture, agriculture, waste management, planning, climate or drinking water and watershed protection are encouraged to apply by November 14, 2022.

Volunteer knowledge and perspectives are a valuable part of the advisory committees that work on a broad range of items that impact our region and its residents. Committee members provide a focal point for co-operation between community interests and the RDN on local governance matters, advise on a wide range of projects and work with community and neighbourhood groups. This year, the RDN is accepting applications for the Board of Variance as well as several committees as follows:

- Board of Variance
- Electoral Area A Parks, Recreation, and Culture Commission
- Parks and Open Space Advisory Committees (Electoral Areas B, C, E, F, G and H)
- Agricultural Advisory Committee
- Climate Action Technical Advisory Committee
- Drinking Water & Watershed Protection Technical Advisory Committee
- Liquid Waste Management Plan Monitoring Committee
- Solid Waste Management Plan Monitoring Advisory Committee

Community members are appointed to the committees by the Regional Board through an open application process. Applicants must demonstrate interest and expertise where required and be able to commit the necessary time for meaningful participation. Appointments will begin upon Board approval later this year and run until December 31 of the applicable one-, two- or three-year term.
