The RDN will be flushing (cleaning) watermain in all RDN Water Service Areas as part of the annual watermain maintenance program. Customers should expect the following between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on the dates listed above:

- Temporary disruption of service
- Intermittent drops in water pressure
- Discolouration of water.

During the flushing, and for a short time when service is resumed, the water may be discoloured. This discolouration is due to disturbed deposits in the pipes and is not harmful. Please do laundry only in the evenings or on the weekend and ensure that you have sufficient water for the day. The RDN is not responsible for any damages resulting from the use of discoloured water.

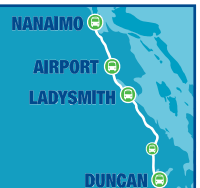
