CURBSIDE ORGANICS COLLECTION EXPANDED

Residents who receive RDN curbside collection can now put leaves, grass and light trimmings in their green-lidded organics cart! Expanding what can go in the organics cart beyond food waste provides an accessible way to dispose of light yard material. This program utilizes your existing 100-litre organics cart. Alternative cart sizes will be considered based on program participation and material volumes.



- Keep the lid completely closed
- If the cart is over 75% full, leave the cart in the unlocked position
- Continue to set your carts out by 8 a.m. until 6 p.m. in your typical collection

The RDN will be flushing (cleaning) watermains in the above RDN Water Service Areas as part of the annual watermain maintenance program. Customers should expect the following between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on the dates listed above:

- Temporary disruption of service
- Intermittent drops in water pressure
- Discolouration of water.

During the flushing, and for a short time when service is resumed, the water may be discoloured. This discolouration is due to disturbed deposits in the pipes and is not harmful. Please do laundry only in the evenings or on the weekend and ensure that you have sufficient water for the day. The RDN is not responsible for any damages resulting from the use of discoloured water.
