Recreation Services

- In Parksville, Oceanside Place Arena is closed effective 4:00 p.m. March 16.
- In Qualicum Beach, Ravensong Aquatic Centre will remain closed.
- All registered recreation programs including day camps and drop-in activities have been cancelled effective 5:00 p.m. March 16.

Transit

- All RDN Transit and HandyDART busses are being sanitized daily.
- Drivers will be monitoring the number of passengers to follow the Public Health Officer's requirement of no gatherings over 50 people.
- At this time, regular Transit service continues. Any changes in service will be posted to our website and social media.
