

Park Amenity Donation Terms and Conditions

Recreation and Parks Department

- The RDN shall have final approval of the bench (or other amenity) type, location, and plaque wording.
- 2. The identity of donors becomes public record. The RDN may publish names to acknowledge a donation.
- 3. The donated amenity is the property of the Regional District of Nanaimo.
- 4. Parks staff reserves the right to relocate or remove the donated amenity whenever necessary.

 All reasonable effort will be made to notify the donor if their donation is affected.
- 5. Placement of memorial wreaths, flowers or other items or any modifications to the amenity will not be permitted.
- 6. Donated assets will be maintained in good condition and repaired as needed by the Regional District of Nanaimo for a 10-year term.
- 7. Once the 10-year term is complete the current donor will have the option of renewal. The cost of renewal will be determined by the fees being charged at that time and whether portions of the original donation (i.e. a bench plaque or bench frame) can be reused. Should the donor opt not to renew their donation the RDN will have the option to offer the location to another donor, leave the item in place or remove the item.
